

# Easiest Pocket Pack Tissue Holder Ever

Fabric Requirements:

- 3 pieces of 4" x 6" fabric
- 2 pieces of 4" x 4" fabric

Fold both 4" x 4" pieces and two of the 4" x 6" pieces in half. Press.

Lay the remaining unfolded 4" x 6" piece right side up. This is the back of the tissue pouch. Next, layer the remaining pieces on top of the backing piece. Make sure the folded edge of each piece faces the middle, not the edge.

Lay one long piece on top of the back piece along one long side. Next, lay a short piece on one end. Next, lay the remaining long piece along the other side and then lay the last short piece on the other end.

Lift the corner of the first piece and tuck the last short piece under. Pin to hold everything in place. (see Figure 2)

Stitch all the way around the outer edges using a 1/2" seam allowance. Trim corners and turn through the opening in the middle. Make sure the corners are fully turned out using your finger or a point turner. Press. Place Kleenex pocket pack into the holder and enjoy!
